THE INCREDIBLE HONEYBEE

Have you ever watched a honeybee visiting a flower? It looks like a tiny, fuzzy pilot buzzing from flower to flower. But behind that busy life is one of the most amazing stories in nature!

Honeybees live in large groups called colonies. A colony can have up to 60,000 bees! Each colony has one queen bee, whose only job is to lay eggs. There are also male bees called drones, but most of the bees are female worker bees. The worker bees do everything — they build the hive, collect food, and take care of the young bees.

Bees communicate in a very special way. When a worker bee finds a field of flowers, she comes back to the hive and does a dance! This dance — called the waggle dance — tells the other bees exactly where the flowers are. It is like sending a map using your own body. How brilliant is that?

Bees collect nectar from flowers and turn it into honey inside the hive. To make just one small jar of honey, bees must visit about two million flowers! Honey never goes bad — scientists have found honey in ancient Egyptian tombs that is over 3,000 years old and still perfectly fine to eat.

But bees do something even more important. When a bee lands on a flower to collect nectar, tiny grains of pollen stick to its fuzzy body. It carries this pollen to the next flower. This helps plants make seeds and fruits. Without bees, many of the vegetables and fruits we eat would not exist. No bees mean no mangoes, no apples, and no cucumbers!

Sadly, the number of honeybees in the world is going down. Chemicals used on farms and cutting down forests are harming them. We can help by planting flowers in our gardens and not using harmful sprays. Even a small pot of flowers on a window can give a bee a meal!

So next time you enjoy a spoonful of honey, remember to thank the tiny, hardworking bee. It worked very hard just for you!

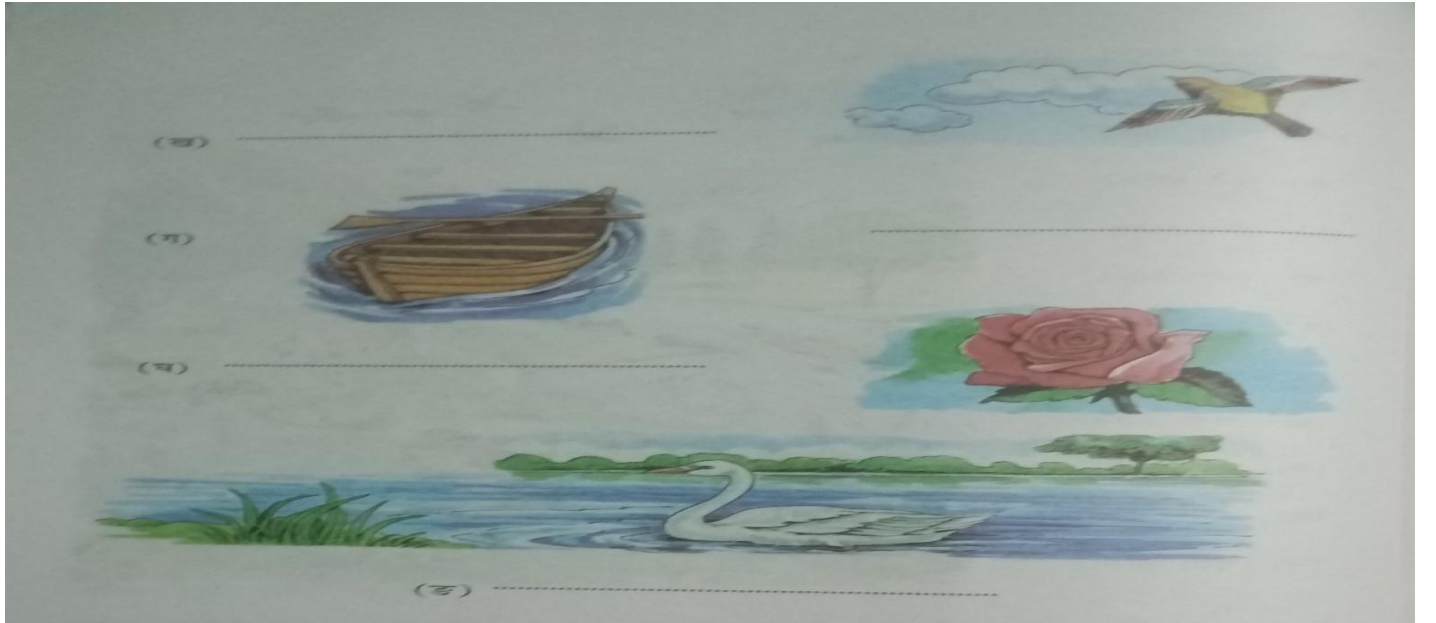

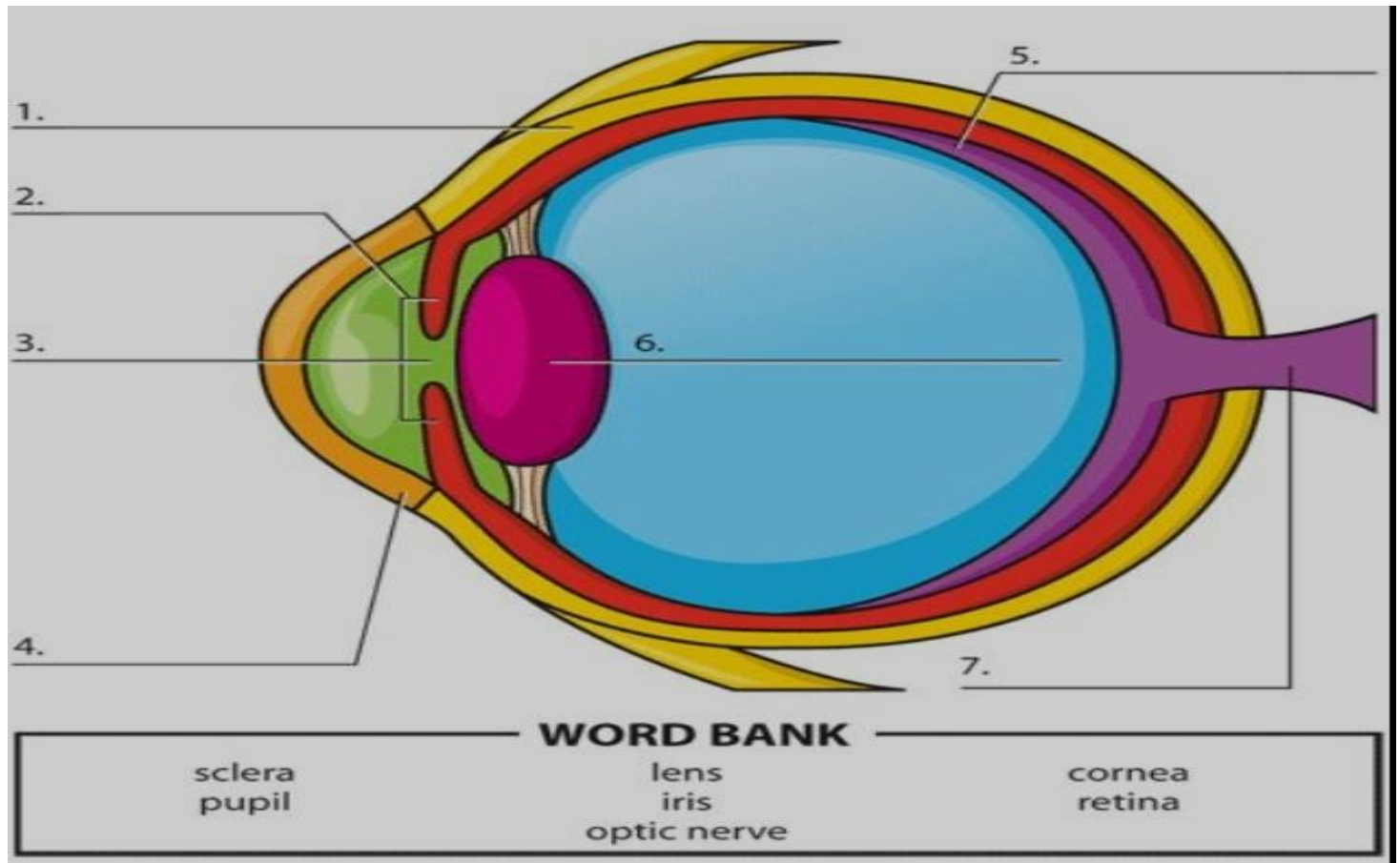
