DIWALI

Diwali is known as the Festival of Lights. It celebrates the Hindu New Year. The date of Diwali changes from year to year. It can be anywhere from late October to early November depending on the moon. In many countries around the world, Diwali is celebrated as a public holiday.

The festival lasts for 5 days with Diwali falling on the 3rd day. It starts 2 days before the new moon comes up. Diwali is known as the darkest night, which explains why the festival is called the Festival of Lights.

Hindus from all over the world celebrate Diwali. They will often clean their house before the festival as they believe the goddess will only visit neat and tidy homes. It is also common for Hindus to decorate their homes with candles, oil lamps and sparklers seeing as it is the Festival of Lights. Hindus also decorate their homes with pictures, toys and flowers, hoping that the goddess will be drawn to their house. Hindus believe that Goddess Lakshmi visits neat and tidy houses on Diwali to bless them with good luck for the year ahead.

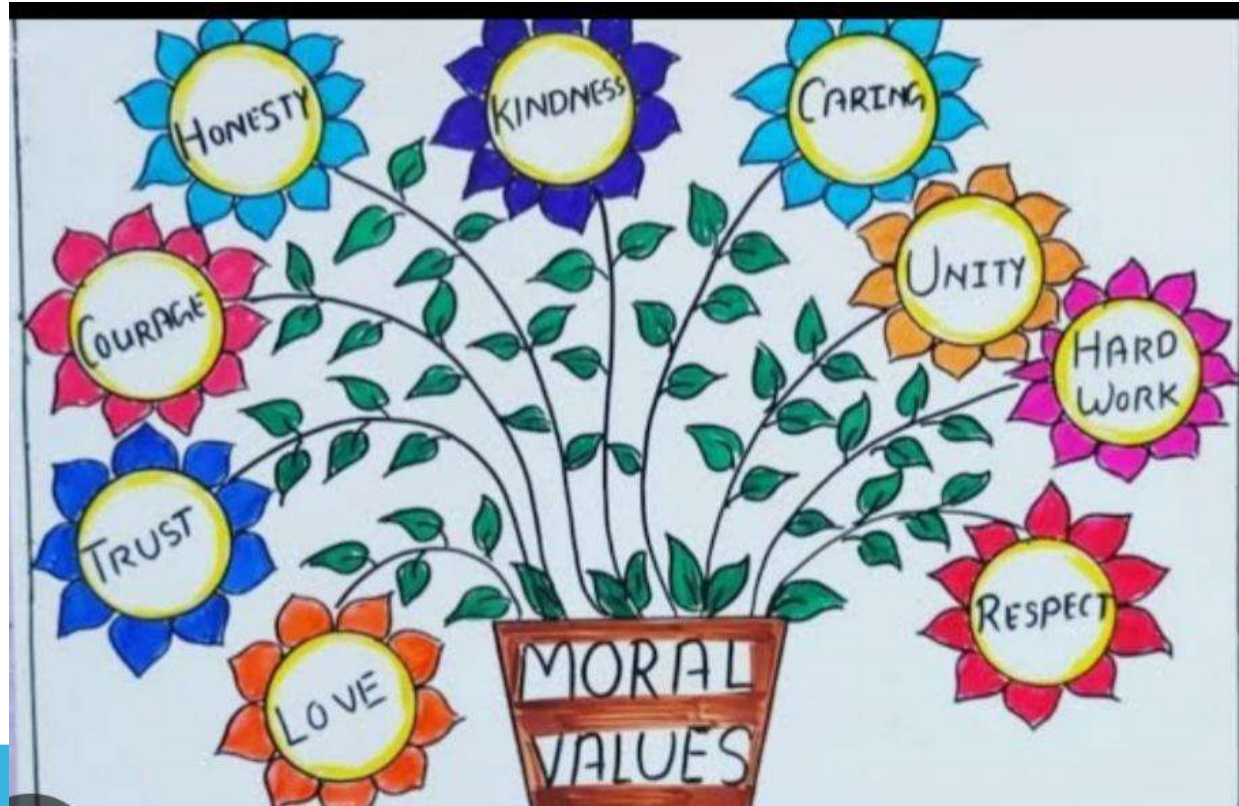
